## Scorer Remuneration Recommendations SACA Premier Cricket 2025/26 Season

In 2017 the South Australian Cricket Umpires and Scorers Association tabled recommendations to the Premier Cricket Committee (PCC) on payments for scorers within the SACA Premier Cricket competition, following a request from clubs via Premier Cricket Committee delegates.

### Rationale for Recommendations

These recommendations are made on the basis that scorers form a valuable part of the match day officials “team” as well as providing an invaluable role for their team/clubs. The payments recommended would be reimbursement for the significant contribution, time and effort that scorers put into ensuring our wonderful game can be played across the state.

Some of the duties scorers provide to clubs include the following:

### Expected/typical duties performed by Club Scorer’s

- Use of PlayHQ Scoring App to upload scores on Match Day (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade as minimum) utilising Frog Box functionality in games being live streamed.
- If Scoring App not available regular updating of scores in PlayHQ by direct input.
- Use of running sheet also referred to as Linear Scoring (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade as minimum) in addition to scoring in Scorebook and/or on computer.
- One scorer scores with electronic scoring and one Paper Scoring in Men’s 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> grades and Woman’s 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades, in accordance with the SACA Bylaws.
- 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Men’s and Woman’s Scorers (home team scorer) utilising the Duckworth Lewis Stern programme/system during all One Day Cup and T20 matches as needed. Includes providing Match Day umpires and captains a copy of print out showing required run rates at the completion of the first innings of the match.
- Confirmation of team and player scores and game results in PlayHQ within 24 hours of game completion.

### Recommendations

Based on the above expectations and duties, it is SACUSA’s recommendation that scorer remuneration for both Men’s and Women’s games for season 2025/26 is as follows:

Grade	Amount	
Men’s 1 <sup>st</sup> Grade & WE Cup	\$130	Per Day
Woman’s 1 <sup>st</sup> Grade	\$130	Per Match/Day
Men’s 2 <sup>nd</sup> Grade	\$110	Per Day
Men’s 3 <sup>rd</sup> & 4 <sup>th</sup> Grade	\$100	Per Day
Women’s 2 <sup>nd</sup> Grade	\$80	Per Match/Day
Men’s and Women’s T20 - 1 <sup>st</sup> Grade	\$80	Per Match
Men’s and Woman’s T20 – 2 <sup>nd</sup> ,3 <sup>rd</sup> & 4 <sup>th</sup> Grades	\$75	Per Match

Recommendations are based on Premier Cricket umpire pay rates and a similar relationship between umpire and scorer pay Cricket Australia use for matches below SS/BBL (e.g. Men's 2<sup>nd</sup> eleven, WNCL, WBBL, underage championships, etc.).
